Some issues raised by Black writers are specific to a certain time period. For example, Frederick Douglass wrote about his experiences as a slave, and Hughes wrote about segregation, when he was sent "to eat in the kitchen," in his poem "I,Too" (line 2). How do you think the issues described in the material read in class compare to the conditions under which African Americans live today? Respond in a well-developed paragraph. Include at least three different sources in your response, and at least three properly documented quotes from material read. Your paragraph should be about a page long.
